

Led Cloverleaf/Shamrock



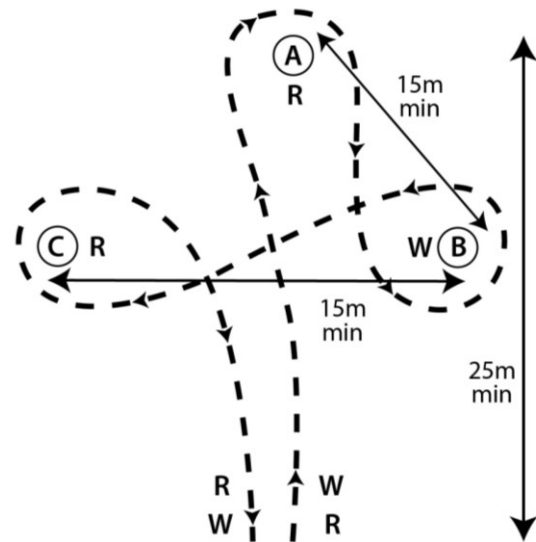
Equipment:

- 3 posts
- 2 pairs red & white flags
- 1 number
- 3 letters and 3 coloured flags (2 red and 1 white)

Objectives:

The rider negotiates the obstacles in order A to C as shown in the diagram without touching them.

Obstacles A and C are ridden from left to right and B from right to left.



R = Red flag W = White flag

Features:

- The cloverleaf consists of 3 loops around obstacles in the order of the letters on the obstacles.
- The obstacles must be at least 5m apart and the distance from the further obstacle to the entrance gate must be 8m (these measurements supersede those shown in the diagram).

Effectiveness faults:

- Touching the posts
- Break in forward movement (change of gait)

Gait evaluation:

- According to the slowest gait (see Scoring Guidelines – Gait sheet for further details).

Marking:

- Effectiveness: marked 7, 4, 1 or 0 depending on the number of faults
- Gait: trot = +3, walk = 0

Where there is a change of gait the obstacle is marked as having been completed at the lowest gait. Resumption of the original gait is not acknowledged.

Penalties:

- Brutality -3 points
- Missing an obstacle results in a zero score for the Led Cloverleaf.
