

Angelsey TREC – Competitor Information

Directions:

Leave A55 at Junction 8

A5025 signed Amlwch

At Benllech turn left onto B5108 signed Llangefni

In Brynteg turn left onto B5110 signed Llangefni

1 mile from the edge of Brynteg (delimit sign) turn into Quarry entrance (CMP Rhuddlan Bach Quarry – yellow sign) – You will see wheel wash on the right.

Venue Field is 1st gate on the right

[Roadworks and contra flow on A55 so make sure you leave it at Junction 8 (just after the bridge from the mainland)]

Venue information

On entering venue please go through the first field and into the second field to set up your corral – aiming for the area marked with the yellow box. Please do not park next to the hedge – we need access along the hedge throughout the event. Also please avoid parking far up the field as the PTV

course will run across the far end of the field.

There is horse water available in the next field – a walk, we will try to make water runs in late afternoon.

There is a reasonable amount of grass and corralling space is fairly abundant but hay for back up may be advisable.

Please be aware – if the sun shines there will be horse flies aplenty!

Sunday afternoon after PTV there will be opportunity to go to Red Wharf Bay (with or without your horse) for paddling in the sea while we get the scores out.

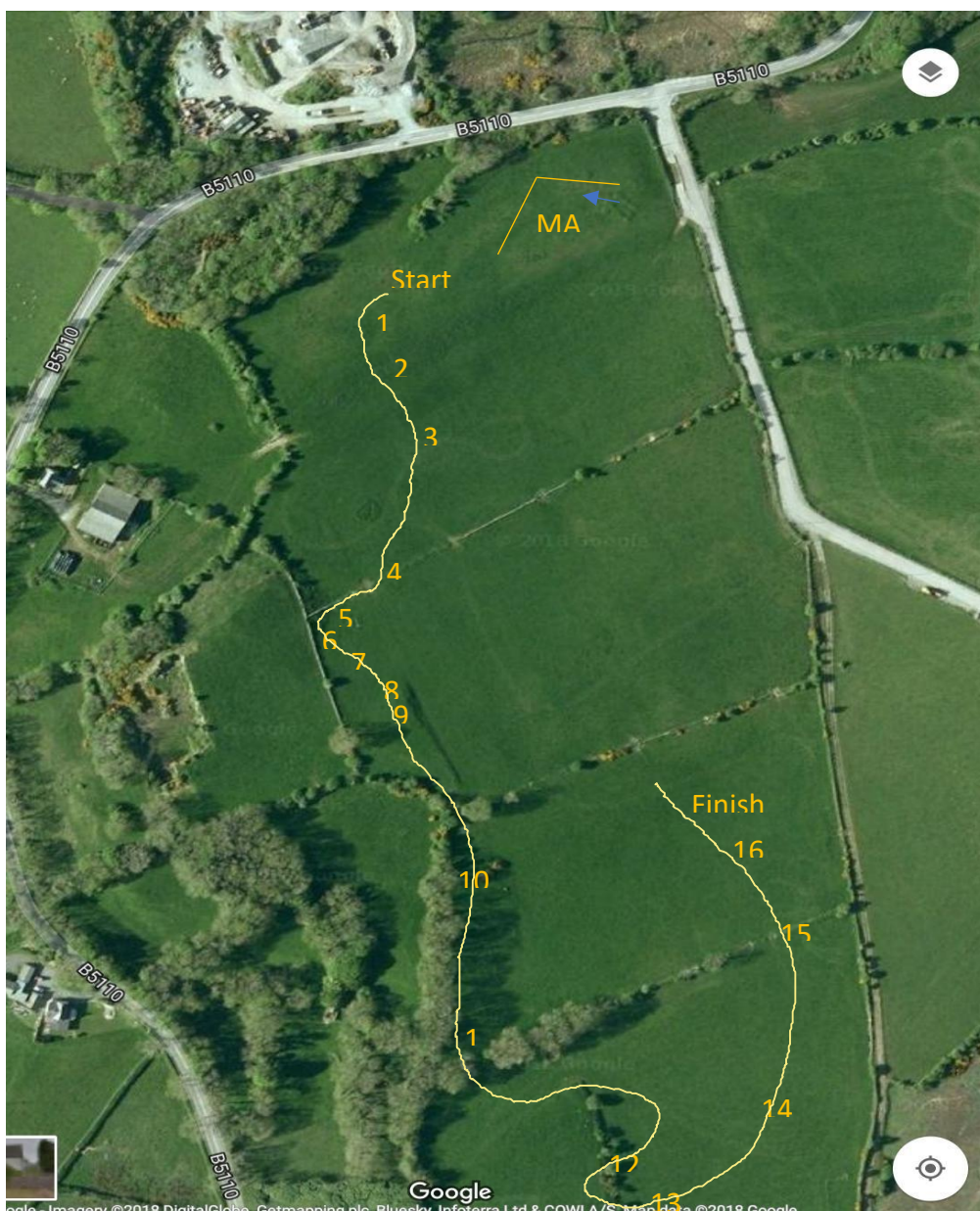
